WHAT DOES Pantex Federal Credit Union DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and account balances
- Account transactions and credit card or other debt
- Credit history and payment history

How?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Pantex Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.	
	Nonaffiliates can include insurance companies, government agencies, plastic card processors, mailhouse, consumer reporting agencies, data processors and check printers.	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
